Uniform Policy (K-12th grade)

All kindergarteners through 12th grade may wear NTA Spirit Wear tops daily. Spirit wear shirts must be worn with uniform pants Monday-Thursday. Jeans may be worn on Fridays.

Pre-K students are not required to wear uniforms.

Uniform Policy (K-3rd grade)

For students in grades K-3 who decide to wear uniform polo shirts, uniforms may be purchased from any store or vendor. All tops will be embroidered with the initials NTA. The letters must be embroidered with 1-inch block-style lettering. The letters will be on the left side of the chest and read NTA in all caps.

Uniform Policy (Grades 4-12)

For students in grades 4-12 who choose to wear uniform polo shirts, all school uniform tops must be purchased from Lands' End, French Toast, or Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms.
